Re: COVID-19. Facility Will Continue Services

On Wednesday, March 18, 2020, Governor Carney modified the March 16, 2020 Declaration of a State of Emergency for the State of Delaware due to a Public Health Threat.

While this modification does not require facilities close their doors, for the safety of participants, groups of more than 10 persons that includes any person aged 60 or over or any person with an underlying health condition in one (1) space (room) are prohibited at this time. In addition, social distancing practices must be utilized at all times.

We are Closely monitoring the situation and taking action. We're following updates on COVID-19, including guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and local health officials. We'll continue to take actions necessary to help protect the community. Specifically, if we are notified of a member or faculty testing positive for COVID-19, they will be temporarily quarantined until they are medically cleared.

Mean while you can Practice good hygiene. Wash your hands frequently. Cover your nose and mouth if you have to sneeze or cough. And use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol content. Please stay home if you are sick. Per the CDC, if you have been diagnosed with COVID-19 or suspect you may have it, you should seek a medical professional for advice.
